Online courses are also available (\$318 credit/hour). Students may also stay in Zimmerman Hall for \$80/wk.

Plus, with Wesley's Summer Advantage, all courses are *WESLEY COURSES TAUGHT BY WESLEY FACULTY*, which means there's no need to worry about obtaining transfer credit approval or paying for transcripts.
